The town of Strathmore is about a 25 minute drive from the city of Calgary. Our schools are among the best in Alberta and our communities are safe and caring.

<u>George Freeman</u> is a beautiful school with the Strathmore Motor Products Sports Centre attached to it. There are two classes of most grades and working together on teacher and student collaboration is a priority. This state-of-the-art shared facility with the town of Strathmore has two full gymnasiums, a large turf field and an elevated walking/ running track. As a result of this great partnership, the school can provide extra sport specific programming to their students.

Core courses for all grades include:

- English Language Arts
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Physical Education
- Fine Arts

Students in Grades 6-9 are eligible to take part in a variety of CTF Option Courses. Currently the following courses are offered:

Grade 6 – Two mandatory courses per semester. Fine Arts in Semester 1 and and Robotics in Semester 2.

Grade 7 – Two mandatory and 1 optional course per semester. Semester 1 students can choose between either Robotics or Foods. In Semester 2 students can choose French and Fine Arts.

Grade 8 – One mandatory and 2 optional courses per semester. In Semester 1 students take French and have a choice of two of the following courses: Entrepreneurship or Film Studies. In Semester 2, students take Fine Arts and have a choice between Outdoor Education and Foods.

Grade g – One mandatory and 2 optional courses per semester. In Semester 1 students have a choice of 2 out of the 3 following courses: Entrepreneurship, Fine Arts or Photo/Video. In Semester 2 students have a choice of 2 out of the 3 following courses: Outdoor Education, Community Recreation or Foods.

Sports Academies

Instruction and skills practice are offered in three different academies. In each academy students get 16 sessions with a highly trained instructor to work on skill development and their love of sport.

Soccer – Beginning of October through to the end of November for grades 2-9. Sessions are offered during the school day.

Baseball – Beginning of February through to the beginning of April for grades 4-9. Sessions are offered during the school day.

Fastball – Beginning of February through to the beginning of April for grades 4-9. Sessions are offered during the school day.
